### INTRODUCTION

For some people Christmas season can be overwhelmingly difficult to the point that they say "who needs Christmas? Some people just don't see the point of Christmas altogether. Why celebrate the birth of some Jewish baby? As it turns out, God needed Christmas. Parents often had this feeling: "I sure wish my kids understood how much I love them." - 1. Talk about a time you had trouble convincing someone else of something you knew to be true. What did you?
- 2. Do you believe that Jesus is God in a body? Which of the following is the most compelling ones that prove Jesus' deity?
  - His ability to control nature: He changed water into wine, he calmed the wind and the waves, etc.
  - The miracles: He walked on water, healed the sick, raised the dead to life.
  - People giving him worship: The magi, the disciples, the blind person, the doubting Thomas,
  - His unique moral character: His compassion, love for the people, and his sinless life.
  - His own claim to be God: He said he and God is one, seeing Him is the same as seeing God.
  - · His resurrection: Jesus predicted his own death and resurrection and actually did it.
- 3. **Read Romans 5:6–8**. What are some truths about God that you wouldn't know if Jesus hadn't demonstrated them?
- 4. What can you do this Christmas season to show gratitude for God's choice to demonstrate his love for you? How can this group help you?
