SERMON SYNOPSIS

March is The Rocks Kingdom Builders month. Kingdom Builders is a faith exercise where we learn to trust God with our finance and practice radical generosity by committing to give our priority percentage giving for the next 12 months towards the vision of our church.. Our Kingdom Builders theme this year is "IMAGINE."

Why do we do Kingdom Builders? There are many reasons but here are 3 important ones

- 1. Our vision is too important for us to ignore. And vision needs funding.
- 2. We want to help you to be generous. The goal is for us to learn to be as generous as we possibly can. Not only generosity blesses people, it reflects appropriately the generous God that we worship. So if you want to be generous you cannot give haphazardly or on impulse. You need to plan your giving (1Cor 16:2).
- 3. Your regular giving makes it easier for us as a church to plan our ministry to reach to the community. When giving is irregular and ad hoc, and unpredictable, it makes life very difficult to everybody. So the more consistent you're giving, the better it is for us to fulfill our vision to reach this city

The result of our Vision Giving Sunday taught us several things:

- 1. The Rocks is a family that is highly committed to God.
- 2. The Economy is not in Control, God is.
- 3. God is far more interested in building our character than in meeting our "need".
- 4. Generosity and Spirituality Go together.
- 5. We are unstoppable if we are united.
